

# STUDENT VOTE WATCH

STUDENT VOTING RIGHTS

## IOWA



SF 47 requires photo ID to vote and includes student IDs as a valid form of voter ID.

*This bill would restrict access to voting, but including student IDs mitigates some impact.*

## IOWA



SF 61 allows preregistration at 17 and voting in primary election if 18 by the general election.

*Preregistration supports young voters.  
Bill was referred to State Government Committee.*

## MARYLAND



SB 141 requires local boards of elections to establish a polling place at higher education institutions with student housing.

*Would increase voting access for out-of-state college students. First reading done in senate.*

## MAINE



LD 121 requires photo ID to vote and includes student IDs as a valid form of voter ID.

*This bill would restrict access to voting, but including student IDs mitigates some impact.*

## NEVADA



SB 94 allows preregistration for 17-year-olds and would establish Election Day registration.

*Election Day registration enables voters to register and vote on the same day. Read first time. To committee.*

## NEW HAMPSHIRE



HB 642 attacks use of student ID as voter ID, student residency for voting, and revokes same-day registration, replacing it with a 30-day registration deadline

*This omnibus bill rolls back voting rights and targets students by requiring student IDs to state whether or not the student is a resident of NH.*

## OKLAHOMA



SB 349 allows preregistration for 16-year-olds.
