## ARIZONA



SB 1223 Adds higher education and Veterans Health IDs to acceptable list of voter IDs.

*Would increase access to voting for students.*

## MICHIGAN



SB 54 Allows for preregistration at age 16, BUT requires a state-issued ID.

*Would expose younger citizens to the process. Referred to Committee on Elections and Government Reform.*

## MINNESOTA



SF 607 allows for preregistration at 16-years-old.

*Increases access to voter registration. Referred to State Government Finance and Policy and Elections Committee.*

## MONTANA



HB 357 implements photo voter ID law. Does not include Student IDs as acceptable voter ID.

*Unnecessarily limits students' ability to cast a ballot. In First House Committee*

## NEW YORK



AB 3843 and SB 4112 require public and private high schools to provide voter registration forms to all students.

*Would provide opportunity to register for high school students. Referred to Election Law Committee.*

## U.S.



H.R.126 , Students Voicing Opinions in Today's Elections (VOTE) Act - Directs EAC to conduct pilot program in 2017 providing funds for voter registration education to 12th graders.

*Would increase education and access for voter registration. Referred to Committee on House Administration.*
