Key Dates

October 7

Voter Registration Deadline

October 21 – November 1

Early in-person voting

October 25 (received, not postmarked)

Absentee* application deadline

November 5

Election Day

Polls Open 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. local time

Completed absentee ballots may be returned in person or by mail. Those returned in person must be taken to the early voting clerk's office while polls are open on Election Day. You will be required to show an acceptable voter ID if returning your ballot in person. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by 7:00pm on Election Day and received no later than 5:00pm the day after Election Day.

* Texas requires an accepted excuse to vote by mail
